Names of persons, places, things, or ideas.

- Red is my favorite color.
- The happy children ran across the lawn in the park.
- Several students from Tom McCall School joined the team.

### Common Nouns

These name any person, place, thing, or idea or group of people, places, and things. They are general. They do not begin with a capital letter in the middle of a sentence.

### Proper Nouns

These name specific persons, places or things. They begin with a capital letter.
