UNDERSTANDING PRONOUNS LESSON

PRONOUNS are words that replace nouns in sentences.

SUBJECT PRONOUNS usually are used at the beginning of sentences. They replace the nouns that would be the subject of the sentences.

Mary threw the ball.
She threw the ball.

The bell rings at 8:45.
It rings at 8:45

OBJECT PRONOUNS usually come later in the sentence. They replace nouns in the predicate.

Mary threw the ball.
Mary threw **it**.

Sam invited John and Paul to go.
He invited **them** to go.

POSSESSIVE PRONOUNS replace nouns and an apostrophe (') that show ownership.

Suzy's book is missing.
Her book is missing.

Luis' and Anthony's team won.
Their team won.

INTERROGATIVE PRONOUNS replace the answer to a question.

Who is going with Dad?
John is going with Dad.

What is she wearing?
She is wearing overalls.

INDEFINITE PRONOUNS replace difficult-to-explain things that are being explained.

Over in the corner by the window are the stacks of notebooks.
There are the stacks of notebooks.
There they are.
